3. personal data shall be processed for the purpose of conducting proceedings and selection of the Economic Operator.
4. personal data will be processed until the withdrawal of consent to the processing of personal data.
5. the legal basis for data processing is Article 6(1)(a) of the abovementioned Regulation.
6. the recipients of your data will be entities that process personal data on the basis of concluded agreements on behalf of the Administrator.
7. the data subject has the right to do so:
  - request access to personal data and their rectification, erasure or restriction of the processing of personal data.
  - the withdrawal of consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of consent prior to its withdrawal.
  - lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority where processing takes place in violation of the provisions of the above regulation, i.e. the President of Personal Data Protection, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw.

Providing personal data is voluntary, and the consequence of not providing personal data is the inability to participate in the proceedings.

Furthermore, we would like to inform you that in connection with the processing of your personal data, you are not subject to decisions which are based solely on automated processing, including profiling, as provided for in Article 22 of the General Data Protection Regulation.
